SUMMARY OF KEY MATTERS DISCUSSED AT THE TWENTY-SECOND ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING ("22ND AGM") OF CAN-ONE HELD AT THE CONFERENCE ROOM, LOT 4, JALAN PERUSAHAAN DUA, 68100 BATU CAVES, SELANGOR DARUL EHSAN, MALAYSIA ON WEDNESDAY, 24 JUNE 2026 AT 10.00 A.M.

Pursuant to Paragraph 9.21(2)(b) of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad's Main Market Listing Requirements ("MMLR"), a listed issuer must publish a summary of key matters discussed at the annual general meeting, as soon as practicable after the conclusion of the annual general meeting.

All the ordinary resolutions that were tabled at the 22nd AGM of Can-One were voted by way of poll in accordance with Paragraph 8.29A(1) of the MMLR, via e-voting and were duly approved by the shareholders, proxies or corporate representative. The shareholders also received the Audited Financial Statements of Can-One group of companies and of Can-One for the financial year ended 31 December 2025, along with the Reports of the Directors and Auditors thereon.
